Comments

The major circulating form of vitamin D is 25-(OH) vitamin D. It is currently the best indicator of Vitamin D status of the body for routine assessments, except in cases with renal diseases.

The total 25-(OH) vitamin D test quantitatively measures the sum of both 25-(OH) vitamin D₂ (cholecalciferol) and 25-(OH) vitamin D₃ (ergocalciferol) in the specimen.
